Policy Statement

The City of Wetaskiwin is committed to ensuring that we are a sustainable community that responsibly manages our infrastructure.

Definitions

Background

- 1. In 2015 the City of Wetaskiwin initiated an Infrastructure Surcharge of 2.5% of the Gross Tax Levy, which was added to the Property Tax Levy in order to assist in the funding of a large ongoing demand for infrastructure upgrades and replacements. In 2015, this amount equated to \$331,130.
- 2. City Council has determined that this surcharge should be increased by 2.5% per year over the next three to five years in order achieve annual infrastructure funding of at least \$1,500,000.

Standards

- 3. The annual surcharge received through the property taxes shall be set aside in the Infrastructure Surcharge Reserve.
- 4. The Infrastructure Surcharge Reserve shall be allocated the appropriate interest through investments.
- 5. The purpose of the reserve is to assist in funding the backlog of infrastructure projects based on the following criteria:
 - a. This reserve shall not be used to fund operating or maintenance items that should be in the annual operating budget.
 - b. Capital projects should have a term life span of at least 20 years.



- c. The use of the reserve shall be limited to the following priorities:
 - i. road infrastructure;
 - ii. sidewalk infrastructure;
 - iii. trail and park system; and
 - iv. building envelope projects.
- d. Additional projects, not specifically listed in c. may be funded by the reserve at the discretion of Council.
- e. This policy will be reviewed annually through the budget process.
